Coronavirus: Emergency response

- Amendments of Rural Development Programmes
- New rural development measure, in addition to existing measures
- Flexibility in the use of financial instruments under rural development
- Higher advances of payments
- Higher state aid possiblities
- CAP flexibility:
 - Extension of deadline for CAP payment applications
 - Fewer farm on-the-spot checks



Coronavirus: new rural development measure – main features

- Exceptional and temporary measure to cope with liquidity problems of farmers and agri-food SMEs
- Lump sum of maximum EUR 7 000 per farmer and EUR 50 000 per SME
- Payments shall be made to the selected beneficiaries by 30/06/2021.
- Maximum 2% of the EAFRD contribution to each RDP
- Large margin of flexibility for MS to target its implementation



Cornavirus: Recovery and Resilience

Recovery Plan for Europe (27/05/2020):

'kick-start the economy, boost green & digital transitions and make it fairer, more resilient and more sustainable for future generations'

- ► Reinforced Multianual Financial Framework 2021-2027 incl. reinforcement of EAFRD + EUR 5.6 bn (cf. COM 2018 MFF proposal)

Wider policy linkages for rural development

- European Green Deal incl Farm To Fork and Biodiversity strategies
- CAP Reform & preparation of MS CAP Strategic Plans
- Long Term Vision for Rural Areas



Long-term vision for rural areas

Why?

 To develop a broadly shared vision and keep rural areas high in the political agenda.

How?

- In close consultation with people living in rural areas, local and regional authorities.
- Should address demography but should also go beyond and embrace all aspects relevant for rural
